Two Passengers Arrested for Attempting to Import Drugs

BARRIGADA, GUAM – On August 15, 2017, two passengers, Yvonne Elliman-Alexander (female) and Allen B. Alexander (male), arrived on a flight from Honolulu, HI. Customs drug detector dog teams alerted to the two passengers who were subsequently referred for further inspection.

During the course of the inspection of their belongings, approximately three grams of a green leafy substance suspected to be marijuana, approximately three grams of suspected crystal methamphetamine, as well as a glass pipe commonly associated with the use of crystal methamphetamine were discovered.

Customs officers placed the two under arrest. They were then transported to the Department of Corrections where they were booked and confined.
