NOTICE OF PROPOSED ASYCUDA
RULES AND PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to 5 GCA §9301 and 5 GCA §73157(g), the Guam Customs and Quarantine Agency (CQA) gives notice of public hearing on proposed rules governing the Automated System for Customs Data (ASYCUDA), Guam's official customs automated system.

SUBJECT MATTER. The proposed rules implement Public Law 38 -109 and establish requirements for ASYCUDA use; electronic customs records and submissions; user registration and access controls; authentication; cybersecurity; system and data integrity; confidentiality; audit trails; data sharing; records retention; revenue controls; risk-management information; continuity of operations and disaster recovery; incident response; system administration; training; external users; compliance; interagency integration; and phased implementation.

PUBLIC INSPECTION. At least (5) copies of the proposed rules will be on file at the CQA Administrative Office at the Guam Integrated Air Cargo Facility, Suite 250, 770 East Sunset Boulevard, Tiyan-Barrigada, Guam from the date of publication of this notice continuously through the hearing and may be examined by any interested person during normal business hours. The proposed rules will also be available on the CQA website.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION. Any interested person, personally or through an authorized representative, may participate at the hearing by presenting facts or argument or submitting written data or views. Written comments should be received by **5:00 p.m. ChST, October 19, 2026**.
